Unplanned

At the March for Life in Ottawa this spring, we heard Abby Johnson speak for pro-life. She did not mince her words and encouraged us to be brave, and not fear in speaking up for the life of the unborn. She told us a little about her life, and her experience, while working for Planned Parenthood which changed her life. And so it was with eager expectation that my wife and I went to see the movie Unplanned, based on her true story about abortion. This movie is very educational and very moving. It opened our eyes to what transpires during an abortion, seeing how a tiny child was fighting in the womb for their life. In the USA, the movie Unplanned was played in many major theatres, where it was widely received. It was a major struggle to have it brought to Canada. Thankfully, some of the smaller theatres agreed to show it. Canada is much less pro-life than the USA. We have no abortion laws, and a woman can terminate a baby, even up to full term. The film, Unplanned, is a good step towards waking people up to the abortion debate and what really goes on in these clinics. Many lives will still be lost before society and abortion laws will change. But change it will! I urge everyone to see this movie, or buy the DVD, and to keep on fighting the battle to save the lives of these innocent little ones. I also like to thank Cineplex Movie theatres for allowing this movie to be shown. Many have tried to stop it being screened, but free speech is still alive and well in Canada. We must protect our right to free speech so that we can continue to speak for the rights of the unborn.

Promotion Report

Our last fiscal year, running May 1st to April 30th, has closed on two successful promotion campaigns. We have chosen to promote our message in two campaigns, one in the spring and one in the fall, to have a greater impact around the city during the campaigns. Last year we were able to run 24 prolife billboards, 30 transit shelter ads, 16 Hamilton Spectator ads, and 16 weeks of K-Lite radio ads between those campaigns. We also advertised in the Mountain News, as well as the SWEAT magazine which goes out to Redeemer University and Mohawk College. This year is proving to be even greater. We have launched a year-round online advertising campaign; this will reach out to women who are looking for an abortion to be directed to pro-life organizations that will help her choose life and provide the necessary resources for that choice. This will run alongside our regular campaigns, which we have also increased. This past spring campaign we ran 20 billboards (up from 12 per campaign) as well as the K-Lite and Spectator ads. We have received a lot of positive feedback from our supporters on our messages, but have also been targeted by pro-choice advocates. Even then, we are encouraged that our message is being noticed and may influence some who see or hear them. Our fall campaign begins in September, so remember to look out for our various pro-life messages!
