Pushing Abortions in Global South

▶ When Donald Trump withdrew support from foreign aid supporting abortions, our Canadian government was very quick to jump into the "breach". Trudeau committed \$650 million to support abortions overseas.

Our government officials say it is not Canada's role to impose our values around the world, yet this policy is in fact saying to the Global South that the "right to abortion" is our national policy, and that we want many of our foreign aid dollars to provide that "right". Objectionable as it is, in practice it is our local policy. Yet, our Supreme Court held in R. v Morgentaler (1988) that there was no constitutional basis in the Charter for the "right" to abortion on demand.

The Canadian Catholic Bishops (via their president, Bishop Douglas Crosby of Hamilton) wrote a letter to the government strongly objecting to this type of foreign aid. They stated that there is no consensus on abortion both at home and abroad; so why insist on such a measure that is strongly disputed at home and abroad while there are so many other undisputed human rights issues which need Canada's support. For example; recently \$119 million was pledged to help the 20 million people who risk starvation in South Sudan, Yemen, Eastern Nigeria and Somalia. Good! But why not spend a lot more of our tax dollars saving lives, rather than on destroying the lives of little ones through abortion?

Your membership dues (\$30 per year from May to next April) would be really appreciated, and any further donations either for the regular work, or for debt-relief would be very much appreciated.

As a result of our tight finances, the board has made a tough decision to restructure ourselves. As of early July, we no longer have a hired Office manager. Sandra is still coming in some of the time on a voluntary basis, together with other volunteers, to manage the various organizational needs of H.R.T.L.. We are very grateful for their hard work. If you can manage to give some hours in office help, please offer us your time!

Please help us financially, enabling us to do our work: to promote in the public sphere the dignity of all human life. God, the Lord of Life, calls us to this task!
