Guest editorial

If you think the pro-life movement is going away, think again! Recently, my wife and I went to a pro-life dinner in Hamilton and more than 250 people attended. A male speaker bravely shared the impact abortion had on him and his wife and how men are affected by abortion too.

And now the good news: Dinner guests were asked to consider a donation to assist in launching a media campaign to further educate the community about the sacredness of human life. Envelopes were placed on the table and collected 10 minutes later. My wife and I and the other couples at our table all contributed, as did many of those at the other tables. I leaned over and whispered to my wife that maybe \$4,000 or \$5,000 would be raised, or roughly \$40-50 a couple. To everyone's amazement, more than \$16,000 - poured in!

Whether the pro-choice world likes it or not, the pro-life movement is not going away. It remains active in Hamilton, Burlington, Toronto and around the world because the stakes are high. With more than 4 million abortions in Canada since the 1970s, and 50 million in America, we need to come to our senses and stop this slaughter.

Life is sacred; it is created by God and needs to be protected. It is heartening to see that so many people care deeply about life issues.

Until abortion and doctor-assisted suicide and euthanasia are things of the past, we are all vulnerable. In Belgium and elsewhere in Europe, this is out of control and patients are often not even consulted but merely killed. The whole mindset is frightening. Who would want to be a doctor or nurse placed in a position of being ordered to participate in the termination of someone's life?

History will show the tragedy of it all. And our own faithfulness to the pro-life cause will also be part of our own history, when we stand before God and become accountable for our own lives. I'm Frank Florio, and that's my take on things.
