President's Remarks BY HARVEY BAILEY, PRESIDENT

Is our mission related to beginning-of-life issues? Yes, it is. As well, we can see an increasing need to focus on end-of-life matters, too. We can and do encounter concepts such as in vitro fertilization, a process called "selective reduction". In reality, what does that mean? We know that many promote the concept of choice, in support of their agenda. We can see and hear a term such as medical assistance in dying (MAID). These terms, used by those with life perspectives other than ours, can be understood to be attempts to soften the impact, or even to deflect from the reality that lies behind these words. Part of our task is to explain and to help with understanding what is involved. Nevertheless, we continue with our programme of education and the recent



showing of the movie Unplanned was an occasion designed to assist with explanations and understanding.

Our activities are not just conceptual, or related to reading a book or seeing a film. There are real, actual, in-person situations that do occur and which illustrate what we are striving to do – to promote the inherent dignity of each human being. What do we say, or not say, do, or not do, when we encounter a beginning of life, or an end of life situation? Sometimes, we may be in a situation whereby we encourage someone to change his or her mind, and to act in support of life. Another time, someone may have already made a positive life decision and we look for a way to support or encourage.

How do we educate? Usually, this takes the form of billboards in public places, as well as the publication of ads in various media. Such promotion campaigns extend throughout the year. We are again planning the Life Chain, and our annual fundraising dinner. We develop communications with other life organizations, which are local, provincial and national in scope, and find ways to combine our efforts.

HRTL appreciates and encourages the support of so many in the community and we urge each of you to continue to find ways to enact your well-considered pro-life motivation. What works for you? Works best for you? Maybe it is prayer, or time and work. Possibly financial, or political. Maybe it is hands-on participation, or attendance at a life event. What about casual conversation, when a life topic comes up and is pursued?

My term as President has come to an end and I extend sincere appreciation to all who are supporters of our organization. You work so diligently, in so many ways. You are greatly to be praised and thanked.
